Officer Nomination Form

According to the Book of Order, Individuals who undertake particular ministries including ruling elder and deacon, should be persons of strong faith, dedicated discipleship, and love of Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Their manner of life should be a demonstration of the Christian gospel in the church and in the world. (PCUSA Book of Order)

All church officers must be active members of the congregation. Terms of office are three years for elders and deacons, and one year for the church nominating committee. Consecutive terms are permitted, but officers are not eligible to serve more than 1 consecutive term. However, officers may be re-elected one year after the completion of a consecutive term. Nominations for First United Presbyterian Church will be accepted for the Class of 2020 between February 26th – March 26th.

Please note: Once elected, officers are expected to attend officer training sessions, monthly session or diaconate meetings, and any committee meetings as scheduled.
