Historian Dr. Carter G. Woodson "The Father of Black History" (1875-1950) founded what is now called the Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH) in 1915.

It is dedicated to gathering and dispersing information about black life, history and culture, and every year the organization chooses the theme for Black History Month.

The year 2013 marks two important anniversaries in the history of African Americans and the United States:

1. The Sesquicentennial of the Emancipation Proclamation and 2. The 50th Anniversary of the march on Washington, where Martin Luther King, Jr. made his famous "I Have a Dream" speech.

The former recognized the coming end of slavery and the latter, for jobs and freedom announced that the days of legal segregation in the United States were numbered.


