# Spiritual Warfare

#### Lesson Text: Ephesians 6:10-11 (AMP)

<sup>10</sup> In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; draw your strength from Him [that strength which His boundless might provides]. <sup>11</sup> Put on God's whole armor [the armor of a heavy-armed soldier which God supplies], that you may be able successfully to stand up against [all] the strategies *and* the deceits of the devil.

**Introduction**: Paul's heart burned with a passion to reach, grow, and help people for Christ. This was so true that even in his final words to a church, his passion and concern to help is clearly seen. His concern to reach and to nurture all came through in every letter he wrote.

#### Paul's Ministry: 1 Cor. 16: 5-9

Paul's first concern was to reach and nurture everyone he could.

Paul planned to "pass through" Macedonia, that is, to make quick visits to the churches in Macedonia.

There is always a need to keep in touch with God's people, strengthening and building them up and reaching everyone he could. This was the constant beat of Paul's heart.

#### Why?

**Note...** Paul wanted to spend the winter with the Corinthian church; however Paul had to remain at Ephesus until Pentecost.

## The reasons for Paul staying at Ephesus: (The Reason for the Assignment)

The opportunity for reaching and growing people was great: there was a "great door" opened to Paul.

## Why?

## The Reason for the Adversaries: (To Hinder and Stop the work of the Lord)

The adversaries of the gospel were many (cp. <u>Acts 19</u> for a picture of the adversaries). Therefore, the young church needed his help to walk through the trial of opposition.

## Paul was able to carry out his plans (Acts 20:2-3).
